

EISB IBDP SCHOLARSHIP POLICY

Ebenezer International School Bangalore through its, 'Scholarship Programs', offers the opportunity to meritorious students to be a part of a learning environment that appreciates merit in **Academics as well as Sports**. Students who wish to seek admission at EISB have the opportunity to apply for scholarship. Existing students of EISB and new students seeking admission are eligible to apply for these Scholarships.

Eligibility criteria for IBDP Scholarship is as under:

IBDP Scholarship:

This scholarship is offered to students who seek admission for IBDP at EISB. The eligibility criterion is strictly based on Board Results (Grade 10). The details of qualifying standards and percentage of scholarship on 'Tuition Fee' are listed in the Grid below:

Note - Scholarship is offered to students in IBDP1 and to be eligible for continuation of the scholarship in IBDP2, the student must score the following standards in final IBDP results. A scholarship Cheque/DD equivalent to the eligible amount shall be issued upon declaration of results.

40%	40 Points
25%	38 Points
10%	36 Points



Students have the opportunity to improve their performance and become eligible for a higher percentage of scholarship in the second year and in the case of drop in performance will also drop down in the category of scholarship.

General regulations governing all scholarship plans:

- a) All decisions of selection of students for scholarship are at the discretion of the management and no representation will be accepted.
- b) Intimation of scholarship will be made in writing signed by the management representative. No oral confirmation should be considered.
- c) Scholarship amount is strictly restricted / calculated only on the tuition fee and all other applicable fees are payable by the student.
- d) The management at any time may withdraw scholarships offered without giving any notice. Students who have joined the school under the scholarship plan will be allowed to continue their education under the scholarship
