

SECONDARY SCHOOL ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP POLICY

EISB through its, '**Academic Scholarship Program**', offers the opportunity to meritorious students enrolling for each Grade 8 & 9 to be a part of the learning environment that appreciates merit in **Academics**. Students who wish to seek admission at EISB have the opportunity to apply for the scholarship. Existing students of EISB and new students seeking admission are eligible to apply for this Scholarship.

Eligibility criteria for the Secondary School Academic Scholarship:

This scholarship is offered to EISB students and external students seeking admission at EISB for Grades 8 and 9. The eligibility criterion is based on the average of cumulative marks obtained by the student in the previous 3 Grades (In case of seeking admission in the middle of the year, the final cumulative marks in previous 2 Grades will be considered along with the cumulative marks in the current year till the date of application). In case the students are awarded Grades in their report cards, equalizing marks as per the grid created at EISB will be used to calculate the percentage of marks.

The percentage of the scholarship will be as per the table below:

Among EISB Students, Scholarship is restricted to top 3 scores (ICSE & CAIE clubbed together to identify the 3 qualifiers). The average score of the previous 3 years will be taken into account

Note: To continue receiving the scholarship in the subsequent years, the students must maintain their merit performance and the percentage of Scholarship (as per the table above) will depend on the final cumulative Grade of the student at the end of the year.

Students have the opportunity to improve their performance and become eligible for a higher percentage of scholarship in the subsequent year and in the case of drop in the performance the category of the scholarship will also drop down.

Upgradation is valid till Grade 10.

General regulations governing all scholarship plans:

- a) Scholarships are available to all the categories of the students:
 1. Day Scholar
 2. Day Boarder
 3. Weekly Boarder
 4. Regular Boarder
- b) However, the scholarship amount is strictly restricted/calculated only on the Tuition Fees applicable to a **Day Scholar** as per the Fee Structure of the grade. All other applicable fees are payable by the student.
- c) All decisions of the selection of students for the scholarship are at the discretion of the management and no representation will be accepted.
- d) Intimation of the scholarship will be made in writing signed by the management representative. No oral confirmation should be considered.
- e) The management at any time may withdraw scholarships offered without giving any notice. Students who have joined the school under the scholarship plan will be allowed to continue their education under the scholarship program for the Academic year in progress.
