

## CRICKET SCHOLARSHIP POLICY

EISB through its, '**Cricket Scholarship Program**', offers the opportunity to meritorious students to be a part of a learning environment that appreciates Cricketing talent. Existing students of EISB and new students seeking admission are eligible to apply for this Scholarship.

### **Eligibility criteria for the Cricket Scholarship:**

To qualify for this scholarship, the student should fulfill one of the criteria as mentioned below. The scholarship is valid for one year only. Renewal/Modification in the criteria is subject to qualification in the subsequent year as per the prevalent scholarship policy.

Students on attaining a higher level of representation in the current/subsequent year will be eligible for a higher percentage of scholarship. In case of a drop in representation in the subsequent year, the category of the scholarship will also dropdown. Representation in one year cannot be reused for scholarship in the subsequent year.

### **General regulations governing the scholarship plan:**

- a) Scholarships are available to all the categories of the students:
  1. Day Scholar
  2. Day Boarder
  3. Weekly Boarder
  4. Regular Boarder
- b) The scholarship amount is strictly restricted/calculated only on the Tuition Fees applicable to a **Day Scholar** as per the Fee Structure of the grade. All other applicable fees are payable by the student.
- c) All decisions for the selection of students for the scholarship are at the discretion of the management and no representation will be accepted.
- d) Intimation of the scholarship will be made in writing signed by the management representative. No oral confirmation should be considered.
- e) The management at any time may withdraw scholarships offered without giving any notice. Students who have joined the school under the scholarship plan will be allowed to continue their education under the scholarship program for the Academic year in progress.
